Phil is a professional action sports athlete. As a snow skater for AmbitionSnow skates, Phil has 3 X games victories, along with 3 Guinness World records for snow skating. He is national pro #10 for the AMA Maxxis Endurocross series.

He was the national champion for the MM12A class at the Maxxis Mini Moto SX in 2007. Having finished in the top 10 in the AMA/NATC Trials championship series, Phil takes his trials skills nationwide with his brother Pat in their motorcycle trials shows. Having recently gotten his feet wet in the USASA snowboard nationals, he is currently trying out his vast talent in the boarder cross world.

Pat is a 3-time AMA/NATC Trials National Champion, as well as a past AMA Rider of the Year. In 2007 Pat became the youngest rider to ever clinch the AMA title. He continued in 2008 and 2009 winning the championship again.

While remaining focused on retaining his U.S. dominance, he became the first rider in more than 30 years to venture overseas and take on the FIM World Championships. Oh, and he can ride a unicycle and bicycle pretty decent too.

In addition to the notorious stunts of the Smage Brothers, the *Tulsa Boat, Sport & Travel Show* will feature The History Channel's *Swamp People*, Hooters Girls and chicken wing eating contest, professional anglers and boat loads of fun family activities you will be talking about for years to come!
